## **In Memoriam**

### **The Rev. Dr. Lloyd Robertson**

It is with deep regret that we announce the passing of The Rev. Dr. Lloyd Robertson. Father Lloyd was one of the founders of Atlantic School of Theology. As the Director of the Holy Heart Theological Institute, he took a leading role in the conversations that led to the founding of AST and became the first President of the School in 1971. His leadership set many of the patterns that made the School a unique ecumenical venture in theological education. Fr. Lloyd continued to take an interest in the life of AST following his retirement. He will be remembered as a kind and thoughtful man who took a real interest in the lives of those around him.

Eric Beresford, the current President of AST, said, "Fr. Lloyd modeled ecumenism in his generosity of spirit and his capacity to find ways of working together across divides that were often assumed to be insurmountable. The continued success of Atlantic School of Theology is a testimony to the power of such generosity and hope."

The school is planning a Service of Thanksgiving for the life and ministry of Fr. Lloyd, details of which will be announced at a later date.

Visitation will be held at St. Agnes Church Wednesday, April 15, from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m., followed by evening prayers at 7:30 p.m. A funeral mass will be held as follows:
