

Hospice Halifax to Open First Residential Palliative Care Facility in NS on AST Campus

I am pleased to announce that AST has signed a long-term lease with Hospice Halifax for 618 and 620 Francklyn Street.

Hospice Halifax announced this morning that the first residential palliative care hospice in Nova Scotia will be built on leased property on the AST campus. The two grey houses at 618/620 Francklyn Street will be renovated and connected in order to make one ten-bed, two-story residential hospice. In addition to ten private rooms for residents, the hospice will include family and children's rooms, a learning and education centre and administrative offices.

This package includes information from Hospice Halifax that may be of interest to you. I encourage you to contact them with your questions.

This lease provides AST relief from operating costs and maintenance on these properties and provides long term, predictable revenue from a like-minded tenant. There may be opportunities for a shared education component. The additional revenue helps support ASTs core mission of shaping effective and faithful leaders and understanding among communities of faith.
