



Administrative Policy: Smoke Free Campus Policy

Purpose

The Purpose of the Smoke Free Campus Policy is to provide a healthy and safe working, learning and living environment on AST campus.

Policy

All smoking, vaping, and use of smoking products is prohibited on campus. This includes, but is not limited to, all forms of tobacco, and all smokable forms of cannabis.

Growing cannabis is prohibited on campus due to impact on resources such as water and electricity, and the risk of fire from heaters and grow lights.

The smoking of both recreational and medicinal cannabis is prohibited on campus. Persons who are authorized to possess medicinal cannabis are encouraged to discuss other methods of consuming medicinal cannabis with their doctor.

The burning of sage, cedar, sweetgrass, or tobacco is an integral part of cultural ceremonies and therefore these substances may be burned on campus for such purposes with written advance permission of the Chief Administrative Officer.
