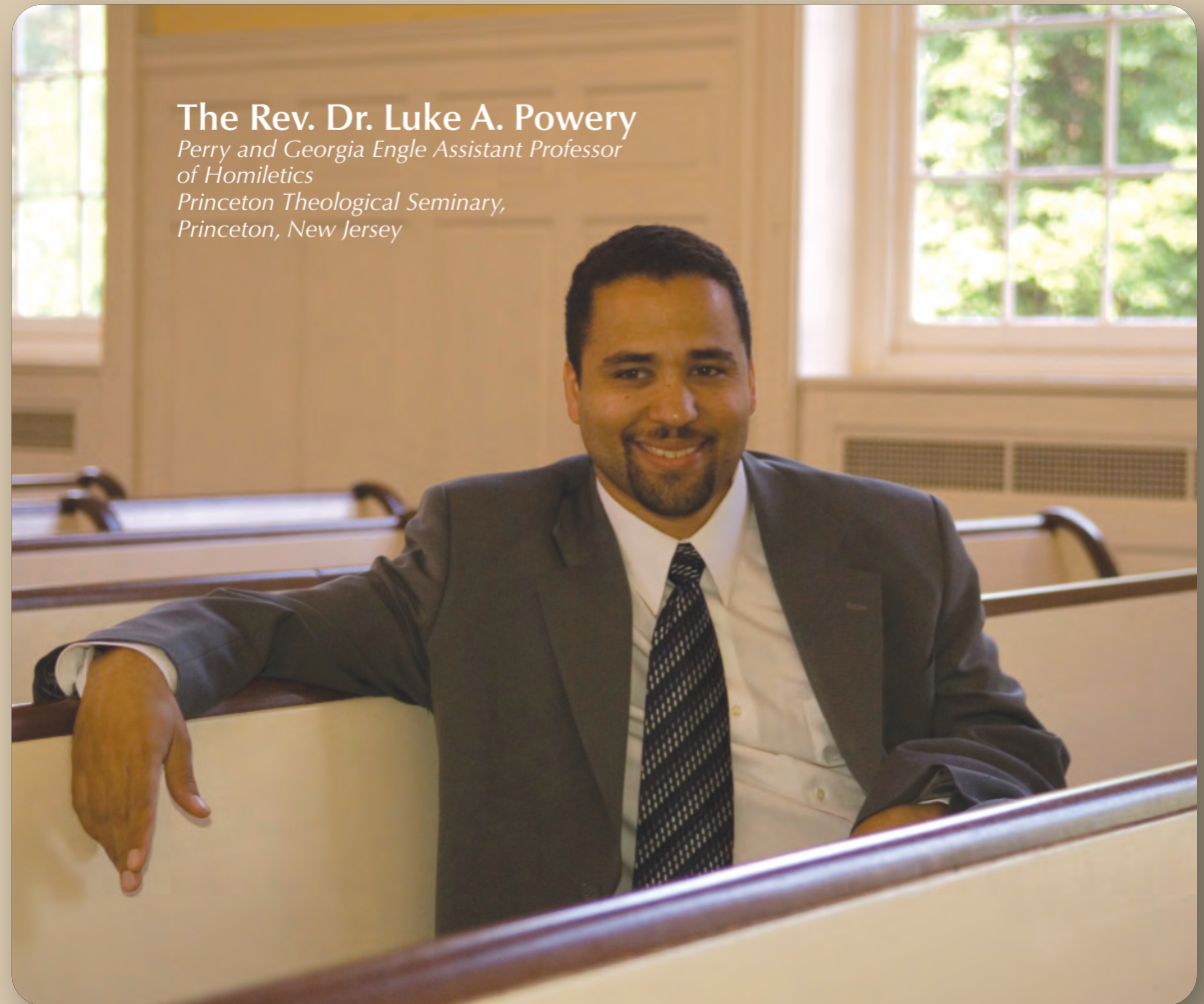

The Nicholson Lectures were established in the early 1980s in memory of Dr. C.M. Nicholson who was Principal of Pine Hill Divinity Hall from 1946 to 1971.
